WINTER PLOWING & PARKING REGULATIONS



Plowing snow across town roads is prohibited. It creates a dangerous situation for traffic and safety hazards for all those who travel that road. *As the property owner, you are responsible for the plowing being done on your property—even if you are paying someone else to remove the snow for you.* Wisconsin Statute 346.94(5) states that no person may place or cause to be placed upon a highway any substance that is or may be injurious to any vehicle. A pile of snow certainly fits this description. **Wisconsin Statute 346.95(3) says that the penalty is \$50 for each offense. Citations will be issued, and no warnings will be given.**



Other plowing regulations:

- You are not permitted to pile snow or block the sidewalks or fire hydrants.
- Parking on town roads and streets shall be prohibited so that plowing can be done quickly and with safety. The parking ban is in effect between the hours of 2:00 and 7:00 a.m. Vehicles in violation will be towed away and tickets will be issued.

PROPERTY TAX RECORDS ONLINE

Did you know that you can view and print your property tax records online? If you go to florencecountywi.com you will find a page with the box "Florence County Quicklinks" on the right side of the page. Click on "Property Tax Records", it is towards the bottom of the list. Here you can search by name or by parcel number. Once you have the correct record, select "taxes" or "assessment" on the top of the page. Make sure that you select the proper tax year to see the amount due. Information is available about one week after tax bills have been distributed by the county treasurer to the township clerks. This is usually the first or second week of December. Once payment is posted, it will also show on the website.

SPRING WEIGHT RESTRICTED ROADS

The Town of Florence enforces a ten-ton weight limit on its roads during the spring thaw to decrease pavement damage. **During this period if you reside on a private road or a town road that comes off a restricted road listed, bring your recycling and garbage to the designated road listed below.** Drop off garbage Tuesday mornings, and enclose your garbage within a garbage can with lid. If you see that garbage is strewn about at your drop off location, please pick it up. Weight restrictions are posted on all main roads within the Town, in the Florence Mining News and on our website at townofflorencewisconsin.com.

GARBAGE COLLECTION (Great American Disposal) & RECYCLING SERVICES (Eagle Waste & Recycling)

Garbage Collection: Florence & Spread Eagle Garbage Pickup is every Tuesday—with only a few exceptions due to holidays. Those dates can be found printed in orange on the calendar on the other side of this page.

- Each bag is required to have a yellow Town of Florence garbage sticker. These stickers are \$1.50 each and available at Pat's Foods, BP in Florence, Bigfoot's Riverside Liquors and the Town Office. If a bag doesn't have a sticker, it won't be picked up.
- Each bag may have up to 30 lbs. of garbage in it. If the bag is heavier than 30 lbs. it will not be picked up.
- If you have questions or concerns regarding garbage pickup, you may reach Great American Disposal directly at 906-774-9006. If you have complaints regarding the garbage pickup you can call the Town of Florence Office.
